#### 2.0 QUALIFICATION:

- (a) (i) Graduation (ii) PG Degree/PG Diploma in Sociology/Social Work/Labour Welfare/Personnel Management/ IR /IRPM/HR/HRM or MBA (Personnel Management/HR /HRM) minimum of two years duration.
- (b) All qualifications must be from UGC recognized Indian University/UGC recognized Indian Deemed University/ Autonomous Indian Institutions/ concerned statutory council (wherever applicable).
- (c) The minimum percentage of marks in the above PG Degree/PG Diploma shall be 60% of marks in aggregate for Un-Reserved (UR), EWS and OBC(NCL) category.
- (d) For Candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwBD category, the minimum percentage of marks in their respective PG Degree/PG Diploma shall be 50%.
- (e) For Departmental candidates belonging to Un-reserved category and OBC (NCL), the minimum percentage of marks in their respective PG Degree/PG Diploma shall be 55%.
- (f) For Departmental candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwBD category, the minimum percentage of marks in their respective PG Degree/PG Diploma shall be 45%.

#### 3.0 AGE LIMIT:

Upper Age limit is 27 years as on last date of submitting online application as described in point no. 6(b) for UR & EWS Candidates. Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years for SC/ST Candidates and 3 years for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Candidates and as per

Govt. of India Guidelines for PwBDs/Ex. Servicemen Candidates on the maximum age of 27 years. For Departmental candidates (NMDC) age relaxation will be given as per the rules of the Company.

#### 7.0 MODE OF SELECTION:

Eligible candidates must have appeared in exam for UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles in Subject Code-55. Based on the UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles score and requirement, candidates will be shortlisted category wise for further selection process (GD & Interview). The final merit list will be prepared based on following weightage of marks. Please note that for recruitment of Executive Trainee in Personnel Discipline, UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles score will only be valid and UGC-NET June-2020 cycle and prior to that is not valid.

### 8.0 RATIO OF CANDIDATES TO BE CALLED FOR GROUP DISCUSSION & INTERVIEW:

The candidates will be called for Group Discussion & Interview based on the score secured in UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles in Subject Code – 55 category wise in the ratio of 1:10. In case two or more candidates in same category secured equal marks in the UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles and the ratio of 1:10 is increasing, all those candidates who secured equal marks will be called for Group Discussion & Interview irrespective of above ratio.

#### 9.0 GROUP DISCUSSION & INTERVIEW:

- i. Based on UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles score in subject code 55, the candidates will be called for Group Discussion and Interview category-wise in the ratio 1:10.
- ii. The Group Discussion Committee will conduct the Group Discussions of the candidates. Topic for Group discussions shall be decided by the Group Discussion committee in advance. The topic for GD may be either discipline-specific or general.

- iii. Group discussions will be held in batches. The number of candidates in each batch will be decided depending upon the number of candidates turned up for Group Discussion.
- iv. Candidates will be called for Interview category-wise in the ratio prescribed above.

#### 10.0 TRAINING & PROBATION:

Candidates selected as Executive Trainee (Personnel) will be placed on training for one year. After successful completion of training the candidates shall be placed under probation for one year.

#### 11.0 PLACEMENT:

The selected candidates shall undergo one-year training at various places. The selected candidates will be posted in any of the Mines/Units/Offices of NMDC Ltd. as per requirements at any stage during service of the candidate in NMDC Limited and they may be assigned job / functions/ assignments as per the business requirement of the Company.

#### **12.0 HEALTH:**

Before joining, candidates will have to undergo Pre-Employment Medical Examination by NMDC recognized Hospital(s) and the decision of NMDC Management, in this regard, will be final and binding. No relaxation in health standards is allowed.

#### 13.0 EMOLUMENTS:

The Executive Trainee (Personnel) will be offered Basic Pay of Rs.50,000/- plus Dearness Allowances (IDA) as per rules of the Company. On successful completion of training of one year, the Executive Trainee (Personnel) will be designated as Assistant Managers (Personnel) in the scale pay of Rs.60,000/- and initial Basic Pay will be fixed at Rs.60,000/- per month.

On successful completion of training, they will be entitled for Basic Pay, Dearness Allowance, perquisites under cafeteria approach, PF, Gratuity, PRP and other allowances and benefits as applicable as per rules of the Company.

Being direct recruitment on initial basic pay, the Company will not bear any liability on account of Salary/leave salary/pension contribution etc. of previous employment, if any.

#### 14.0 VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS WITH ORIGINALS:-

The candidates who will be shortlisted and called for GD & Interview are required to produce original documents/testimonials, along with self attested photo copies, in support of Age, Qualification, Caste (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwBD/Ex-servicemen) certificates, UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles Admit Card, UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles Score Card in subject code 55, NMDC Application form etc. for verification of their eligibility as per notification at the time of GD & Interview. In case the candidate(s) do not produce/submit the required documents before attending Group Discussion & Interview, the candidate(s) will not be permitted to attend GD & Interview and Travelling Allowance will not be reimbursed. The decision of NMDC Management is final in this regard.

#### 15.0 GENERAL CONDITIONS:

- 15.1 The date of birth as well as the name of the applicant will invariably be taken from 10<sup>th</sup> class certificate issued by the recognized Board and no other proof of date of birth and name shall be accepted.
- 15.2 The cut-off date for reckoning eligibility for age will be the last date for submitting on-line application as mentioned at point no. 6(b) of this notification. In case, the last date of submitting of application is extended, the original cutoff date for reckoning eligibility will remain unchanged.
- 15.3 The prescribed minimum educational qualifications are mandatory and in the absence of the same any higher qualification even if possessed by the candidate does not make any candidate eligible to be called for Group Discussion & Interview.
- 15.4 NMDC Management reserves the right to alter/ fix the criteria for calling the candidates for GD & Interview on the basis of UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles Score of Subject Code 55.
- 15.5 During recruitment process, if any information provided by the candidate is found incorrect/incomplete or it is not conformity with eligibility criteria as specified in the notification for the above post or if it is found that candidate has concealed / distorted any material information his/her candidature will be cancelled at any stage during the recruitment process or even after selection.
- 15.6 Mere fulfilling of the minimum criteria will not vest any right in candidates for being called for different stages of recruitment process. Depending upon response and requirement, the management reserves the right to raise/relax/cancel/ modify/alter the entire recruitment/selection process, if need so arises, without issuing any further notice or assigning any reason whatsoever. Decision of management to call the candidates for selection shall be final. No interim correspondence will be entertained.
- 15.7 In case of any typographical errors or omissions, clarification, corrigendum to the notification shall be issued in NMDC website only. In such cases, the last date of receipt of applications will also be extended. In general, no modification in notified specifications/criteria would be made after issue of employment notification.
- 15.8 Before applying Online, all the candidates must fulfill the essential requirements of the post and other conditions stipulated in the advertisement. They are advised to satisfy themselves before applying. No enquiry asking for advice as to eligibility will be entertained. While applying for above post, the applicant should ensure that he/she fulfills all the eligibility and other criteria mentioned above as on the cutoff date and that the particulars furnished are correct in all respects.
- 15.9 All the Outstation eligible candidates called and attended for GD & Interview will be reimbursed Travelling Allowance of second A/C Two Tier Rail/Bus fare on production of Railway/Bus tickets by shortest route as per rules. (TA Form attached as Annexure I).
- 15.10 At the time of attending GD & Interview candidates are required to submit duly filled-in Travelling Allowance form along with its required travelling tickets in original

for its re-imbursement to the candidates as per eligibility. However, the said Travelling Allowance will be paid through e-payment by NMDC in due course.

- 15.11 (A) Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/EWS/PwBD/Exservicemen category should attach a copy of caste/permanent Certificate as applicable in the prescribed proforma specified by Govt. of India. The OBC (NCL)certificate submitted by the candidate should be issued within 06 months from the date of Interview and as per the orders contained in Department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public grievance and Pensions, New Delhi, Office Memorandum No.36012/22/93-Estt(SCT) dated 08.09.93 and should clearly indicating that the candidate does not belong to the persons/sections (Creamy Layer) as mentioned in column-3 of the Schedule of the above referred Office Memorandum dated 08.09.93 and also belong to the community listed as OBC (NCL) by Government of India as per latest directives issued by Government of India.
- 15.11 (B) Candidates seeking reservation under EWS will have to submit, an Income and Asset Certificate issued by the Competent Authority. The prescribed format and the competent authority for the said certificate have been mentioned in DOPT Office Memorandum No.36039/1/2019 dated 31.1.19. (EWS Certificate format attached as Annexure IV).
- 15.11 (C) Category (SC/ST/OBC(NCL)/EWS/PwBD) once filled in the online application form will not be changed and no benefit of other category will be admissible later on.
- 15.11 (D) Wherein in any recruitment year any vacancy earmarked for EWS category cannot be filled up due to non-availability of a suitable candidate belonging to EWS, such vacancies for that particular recruitment year shall not be carried forward to the next recruitment year as backlog and the vacancy will be filled by other than EWS candidate.
- 15.12 If the SC/ST/OBC(NCL)/EWS/PwBD certificate has been issued in a language other than English/Hindi, the candidates will be required to submit a self-certified translated copy of the same either in English or Hindi.
- 15.13 Ex-servicemen are required to produce equivalence certificate of his/her qualification acquired by them issued by the competent authority at the time of GD & Interview. In absence of the above, candidates shall not be allowed to appear in the Group Discussion & Interview.
- 15.14 The prescribed Travelling Allowance claim form (Annexure-I), caste certificates for SC/ST (Annexure-II), OBC (NCL) Certificate (Annexure-III), EWS certificate (Annexure-IV) are available in the notification on the Careers page of NMDC website i.e. www.nmdc.co.in only.
- 15.15 The term departmental candidates means only those candidates who are currently working with NMDC as permanent employees.
- 15.16 Information regarding Group Discussion and Interview will be provided in the Admit Card/Call Letter which can be obtained at Careers Page of NMDC website and candidates will be intimated for the same through their email etc. No other communication will be sent to the candidates for Group Discussion and Interview.

- 15.17 The candidates applying for the recruitment should ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions for the post against which they apply. Their admission at all the stages of selection process will be purely provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility condition. Mere applying through online mode and issue of Application No.for online application / call letter /admit card to the candidate will not imply that his / her candidature has been finally cleared by NMDC. NMDC takes up verification of eligibility conditions with reference to original documents of the shortlisted candidates at the time of Group Discussion and Interview.
- 15.18 Candidates, if shortlisted for Group Discussion & Interview, are required to bring their original UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles score card as received from UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles, at the time of Group Discussion & Interview.
- 15.19 No interim correspondence will be entertained on any account during recruitment process. Canvassing in any form will be treated as disqualification.
- 15.20 Candidates should retain their printed copy of application form and UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles Admit Card /Score Card as they can be asked to produce it for future reference.
- 15.21 In case of disparity in English & Hindi version of advertisement, English version will prevail.
- 15.22 Wherever CGPA/letter grade in a PG Degree/Diploma is awarded; equivalent percentage of marks should be indicated in the online application form as per the norms adopted by the University/Institute. The candidate will have to produce a copy of these norms with respect to his/her University/Institute at the time of Group Discussion & Interview. Where no norms have been specified, the CGPA/Grade will be presumed to have been provided on a 10 point scale.
- 15.23 Only such PwBD category candidates would be eligible to get the applicable benefit of reservation/concessions whose relevant disability percentage is 40% and above.
- 15.24 Court of jurisdiction for any dispute will be at Hyderabad.
- 15.25 Only Indian Nationals are eligible for applying.
- 15.26 It may be noted that applications without valid UGC-NET December-2020 & June-2021 cycles Score Card will be rejected. No request for change of GD and Interview centre will be entertained.
