2.	 <u>Procedure for Online Registration</u> (a) All candidates to log in to <u>www.joinindianarmy.nic.in</u>, check their eligibility status and create their profile. (b) Online Registration (submission of application) will commence from <u>13 February 24</u> to 22 March 24.
	(c) <u>Examination Fee</u> . Examination fee of Rs 250/- per applicant is to be paid by the candidate for the online examination. The candidate on successfully filling the application will be directed to SBI portal through a link on the website. At the SBI portal make payment of Rs 250/- plus Bank charges as applicable. The payment can be made through any of these payment options available:-

(v) In case a candidate is found to have made fake claims at any stage or furnished fake certificate to unfairly secure Bonus Marks, his candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage of recruitment.

(vi) In case any candidate achieves a higher class qualification cert for bonus marks (i.e. NCC cert & sports event cert) between filling of online application & attending rally, such candidate will be awarded higher bonus marks on presenting original document at rally site during rally.

SEQUENCE OF RECRUITMENT

5. Recruitment Process. Recruitment process will be conducted in two phases:-

(a) **<u>Phase-I</u>**. Online Common Entrance Exam at Computer Based Test Centres spread pan India.

(b) **Phase- II**. Recruitment Rally by Army Recruiting Office at Rally Venue.

PHASE- I : ONLINE COMMON ENTRANCE EXAM (ONLINE CEE)

6. Online CEE.

(a) Candidates can download Admit Card after clicking the link on Join Indian Army website. Candidate has to put his user name (which is the Roll Number of candidate) and Password as received by SMS/Email.

(b) Candidates should download their Admit Card & carry a colour printout at the exam centre. All instructions given on Admit Card must be read by the candidates carefully and they should adhere to the instructions. (c) Candidates are required to arrive at exam centre **minimum 30 minutes prior** to reporting time as indicated on Admit Card.

(d) No electronic gadgets are permitted at the examination centres. Candidates will undergo following activities at the exam centre:-

- (i) Frisking at Entry Gate.
- (ii) Checking of Admit Card & AADHAAR Card at the checking point
- (iii) Auto allotment of Exam Hall.
- (iv) Attendance at Exam Hall gate.
- (v) Capture of Biometric (Photo & thumb impression) inside the exam hall.
- (vi) Login ID to allotted computer terminal.
- (vii) Appear for test as per procedure.
- (viii) Exit Biometric before exiting the Examination Hall.

(e) Online test will be objective Multiple Choice Question (MCQ). As per category of application the candidates would be required to answer 50 questions in one hour or 100 questions in two hours.

- (f) Marking pattern for online test:-
 - (i) Full marks for every correct answer.
 - (ii) Nil marks for unattempted question.
 - (iii) 25% marks shall be deducted for every attempted wrong answer (Negative marks).

(g) Marks scored by the candidates in Online CEE will be Normalised to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question paper across different sessions.

7. Additional information for candidates till **Phase-I** of the selection process:-

(a) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centres. All possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.

(b) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.

(c) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.

PHASE – II : RECRUITMENT RALLY BY ARMY RECRUITING OFFICE

8. Proportionate to the vacancies available candidates would be shortlisted by applying a cut off in **Online Common Entrance Exam** result. The Roll No of the candidates who are in merit will be published on Join Indian Army website. These candidates will receive a second admit card for balance of recruitment process as per Rally Schedule of **Zonal Recruiting Office (Bihar & Jharkhand)**. The admit card for **Phase-II** of recruitment process can also be downloaded online under candidate's login (profile) on Join Indian Army web portal <u>www.joinindianarmy.nic.in</u> Shortlisted candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for **phase-II** at the designated Recruitment Rally venue with following documents/certificates in original along with two attested photocopies with them:-

(a) <u>Admit Card</u>. Printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper 75 GSM paper in black and white only **(Do not shrink the size)**.

(b) **<u>Photograph.</u>** Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months

old. Computerised/Photocopied/Photoshopped photographs will **NOT be accepted. Photographs must be with proper haircut and clean shave (except Sikh Candidates)**.

(c) <u>Education Certificates</u>.

(i) Education Certificates with marks sheet of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e. Matric/Intermediate etc from recognised School/ College / Board/University.

(ii) Provisional/online education certificate should be certified in ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University.

(iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by Block Education Officer (BEO)/ District Education Officer (DEO).

(iv) List of Education Board recognized by State Governments / UT administrations is attach as **Appendix 'A'** will only be accepted.

(d) **Domicile (Nativity) Certificate**. Domicile (Nativity) Certificate generated online through Bihar/ Jharkhand Government website and digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/ District Magistrate which can be verified from Government web site will only be acceptable. **No Tatkal Domicile (Residential) certificate will be acceptable)**.

(e) <u>Class/Caste Certificate</u>. Class/Caste Certificate generated online through Bihar/ Jharkhand Government website as applicable and digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/District Magistrate which can be verified from Government web site will only be accepted. For Adivasi, the caste certificate should be issued by District Magistrate only.

(f) <u>Religion Certificate</u>. Religion Certificate to be issued by the Tehsildar/ SDM (If religion as "SIKH/ HINDU/ MUSLIM/ CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in caste certificate).

(g) <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/ College Principal/ Headmaster where the candidates last studied.

(h) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation within last six months. Certificate issued by Mukhiya will not be acceptable. Character certificate without photo attested by certificate issuing authority will be rejected.

(j) Character Certificate Issued by SP/SSP Office.

(i) <u>For Bihar State</u>. Character Certificate duly affixed with individual's photograph issued **digitally by SP/SSP Office of district concerned within** last six **months** which can be verified from Government web site. Character certificate without photo attested by certificate issuing authority will be rejected.

(ii) <u>For Jharkhand State</u>. Character Certificate duly affixed with individual's photograph issued **digitally/manually by SP/SSP Office of district concerned within last six months**. Character Certificate without photo attested by certificate issuing authority will be rejected.

(k) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Unmarried Certificate for candidates below the age of 21 years with photographs issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation with in last six months. Certificate issued by Mukhiya will not be acceptable. Format of Unmarried Certificate is attached as per <u>Appendix 'B'</u>.

(I) <u>Relationship Certificate</u>. SOS/SOEX/SOW/SOWW Candidates are required to produce the following documents:-

(i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Records Office only duly signed by Records Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Records Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water marks of the concerned Records.

(ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/Executive/Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. Format of affidavit is attached as per <u>Appendix 'C'</u>.

(iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.

(m) <u>NCC Certificate</u>. NCC A/B/C Certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. NCC A/B/C pass certificates will only be accepted. No bonus marks will be allotted unless the certificates (Relationship/ Sports/ NCC) have been verified by concerned authorities. An undertaking to the effect will be obtained from the candidate.

(n) <u>Affidavit</u>. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. Format of affidavit attached as per <u>Appendix 'D'</u>. Submission of Affidavit is mandatory to gain entry into the rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit.

(o) <u>Certificate of Bonus Marks</u>. All original certificates / photocopies duly attested pertaining to Bonus marks will be accepted only during the Rally. No certificates to include NCC Certificates, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificates to claim Bonus Marks/ Relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Rally.

(p) **PAN Card & AADHAAR Card**. PAN Card & AADHAAR Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for purpose of Pay & allowances and other social benefits scheme.

(q) Sarpanch/Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof).

(r) <u>Tattoo</u>.

(i) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/from tribal areas, are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. Such candidates will only be permitted on producing the following two certificates: -

(aa) Self certification certificate to be signed by the candidates is attached as **Appendix 'E-I'.**

(ab) Certificate of belonging to a tribal community and permissibility of permanent Body Tattoo(s) to be signed by DC/DM or SDM of the District/Tehsil where the tribe of the candidates is presently settled is attached as **Appendix 'E-II'** (Name and designation of the concerned official must be clearly mentioned).

(ii) Permanent body tattoos of religious sentiment are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e. from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.

<u>Note</u> : Candidates are strongly advised to carry all documents at rally site on the day of their physical test & documentation check. No certificate will be accepted during or after the rally except for the nominated day.

Recruitment Rally

9. Candidates will be tested as stated below during the **Phase-II**:-

(a) <u>Physical Fitness Test (At Rally Site)</u>

(b) **<u>Physical Measurement Test (At Rally Site)</u>**. Physical measurement will be carried out as per the laid down Physical standards.

(c) <u>Adaptability Test</u>. All candidates who qualifies the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) & Physical Measurement Test (PMT) will have to undertake Adaptability Test as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test is for selection of candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Army and are able to adapt to the challenges of military life. Those candidates who will qualify the Adaptability Test will be eligible for medical & further recruitment process. Those candidates who do not qualify the Adaptability Test will not be allowed for further participation in recruitment process. Candidates will be allowed to carry their Smart Phones for the duration of Adaptably Test.

(d) <u>Medical Examination.</u>

(i) Medical examination of candidates who qualify in Physical Fitness Test and Physical Measurement Test will be conducted by Army Medical Team at the Rally site as per Army Medical standards and policy in vogue on the subject issue.

(ii) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH for specialist review. Candidates to report to designated Military Hospital within <u>five days</u> from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within <u>seven days</u> as per policy.

(iii) The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial med examination, review medical examination and med examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Army standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or appeal or re-review after the review medical examination.

(iv) Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Army.

<u>Note</u>: Candidates discharged from the Indian Armed Forces for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

10. Important Instructions

(a) Any candidate who has not received admit card for Phase-II, <u>five days</u> prior to the Rally, may approach concerned Army Recruiting Office for further clarification.

(b) <u>**01 October 2024**</u> will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for candidate. Candidates to produce birth certificate/10th class mark sheet at the time of preliminary document check.

(c) Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by 0100 hours on their respective scheduled dates (**Phase-II**). Candidates reporting after 0600 hours without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally. <u>Candidate should be clean shaven</u> (Except Sikh Candidate).

(d) Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number is **MUST**. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID/Mobile Number like short listed/call letter/joining instructions/result etc. Sharing of e-mail ID and Mobile Number are not permitted. Remember the User Name and Password for future use. (Army Recruiting Office will not be responsible for not getting required information if e-mail / Mobile Number of candidates given is wrong/ changed).

(e) Candidate must carry their AADHAAR Card as proof of identity which could be authenticated biometrically at the Rally Site. Candidates to ensure AADHAAR details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and the Online Application.

(f) Candidate's Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and DOB must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/10th Class Board Certificate.

(g) Candidate must enter contact details and permanent home address exactly as per Domicile/Nativity/Permanent Residential Certificate issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate/ District Magistrate. Candidates participating in different rallies using **multiple nativity** certificates will be rejected under fraudulent enrolment and will be liable for legal action in addition to rejection of candidature.

(h) Those not in possession of required documents will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.

(j) <u>Malpractices</u>. Recruitment into the army is fair, transparent and is based purely on merit. Selection process during recruitment at all stages is automated. Advisory for candidates is as under :-

(i) <u>Touts</u>. In the past, a number of candidates have been found victims of touts, fake documents/impersonation and in the bargain have lost their candidature. Modus operandi/ means used by the touts are as under: -

(aa) Issue of fake PFT Slips/impersonation during various stages of rally. Conduct fake recruitment rallies.

(ab) Snatching/taking away original certificates from candidates who have been declared fit at initial stage and thereafter harassing them.

(ac) Taking away "ADMIT CARD" from the candidates under plea that they will follow up their results.

(ad) Giving candidates false assurance of RECRUITMENT as they claim to have links at appropriate level, thereby winning confidence of candidates.

(ae) Once a candidate gets through on his own efforts, touts demand money in return of the original certificates.

(ii) <u>Bribes</u>. Giving/taking bribe, production of bogus/fake certificates and indulging in unfair means is a criminal offence and liable for punishment under law. Such candidates will be handed over to Civil Police and their candidature cancelled.

(k) A Grievance Cell will be established at the Rally Site to redress any grievances.

(I) Recruitment is purely based on merit depending on available vacancies. Candidates do not have any right to claim recruitment in Army for merely having passed in recruitment process.

(m) Admit Card.

(i) Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card in duplicate generated online through the official website <u>www.joinindianarmy.nic.in</u>, Anyone found with fake admit card will be handed over to Civil Police.

(ii) Candidates to come for the rally only on the date as per Admit Card. Candidates should bring pen, handkerchief.

(n) Candidates are advised to check their age & education criteria before participating in the rally. Candidates found under age/overage and not meeting education criteria will be disqualified.

(o) Certificates with overwriting and tampering of seals or erasing/alteration of any type will not be accepted.

(p) All documents submitted by the candidates are verified by government agencies before enrolment into Army. Strong legal action will be taken against individuals submitting fake documents. Even after recruitment, the service will be terminated if candidates are found to have produced fake documents or gave wrong information at the time of recruitment, despite the number of years of service individual may have rendered.

(q) No compensation for Death/Injury/loss etc during the rally and no travelling allowance/dearness allowance for journey is admissible.
